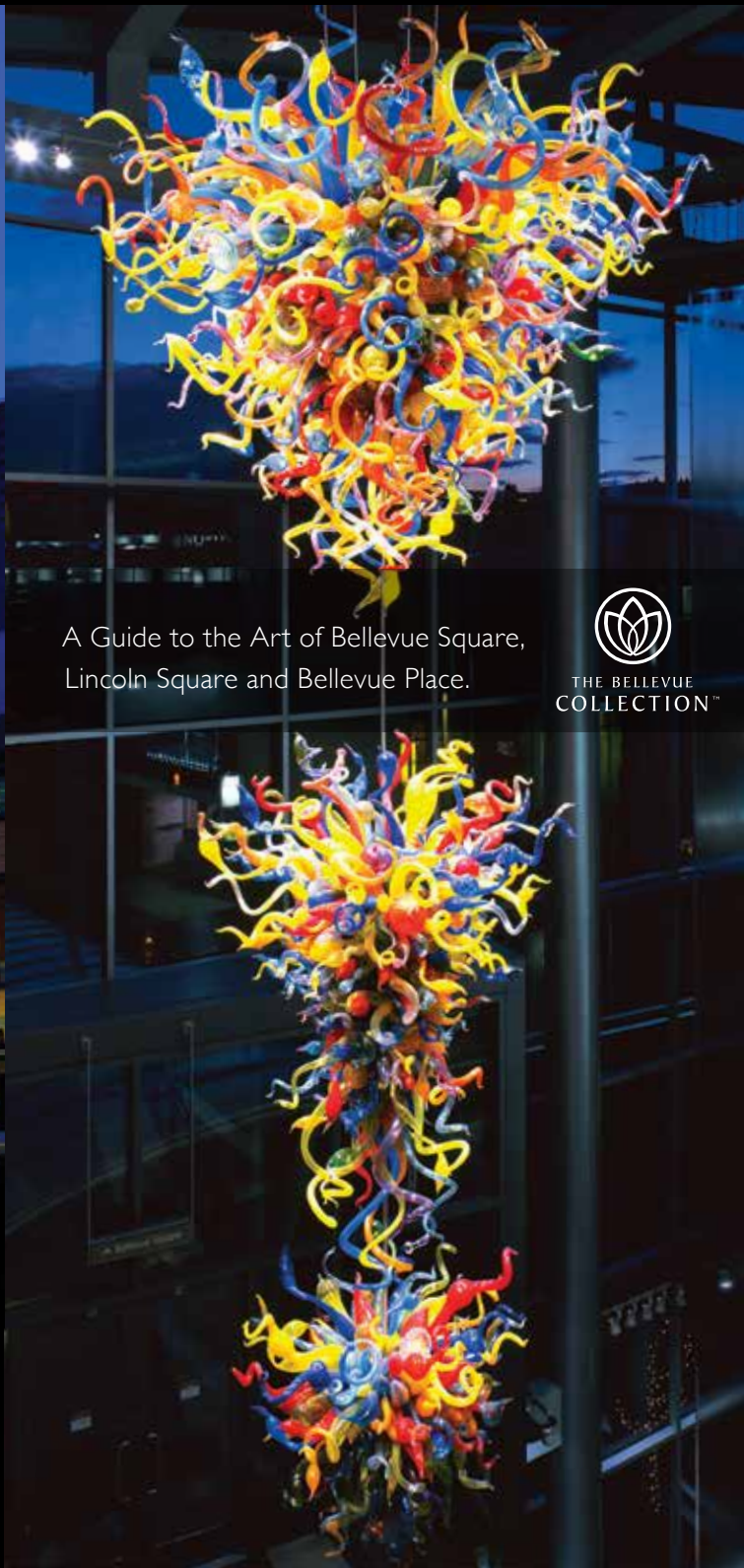
At The Bellevue Collection, we believe the positive relationship between art and a community reveals a historical continuum and provides a legacy for future generations.

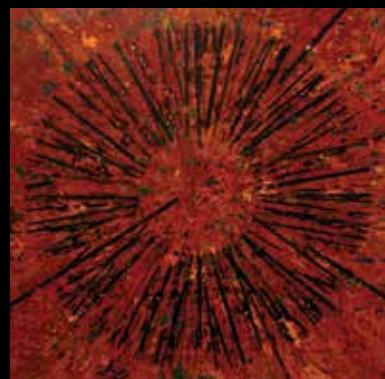

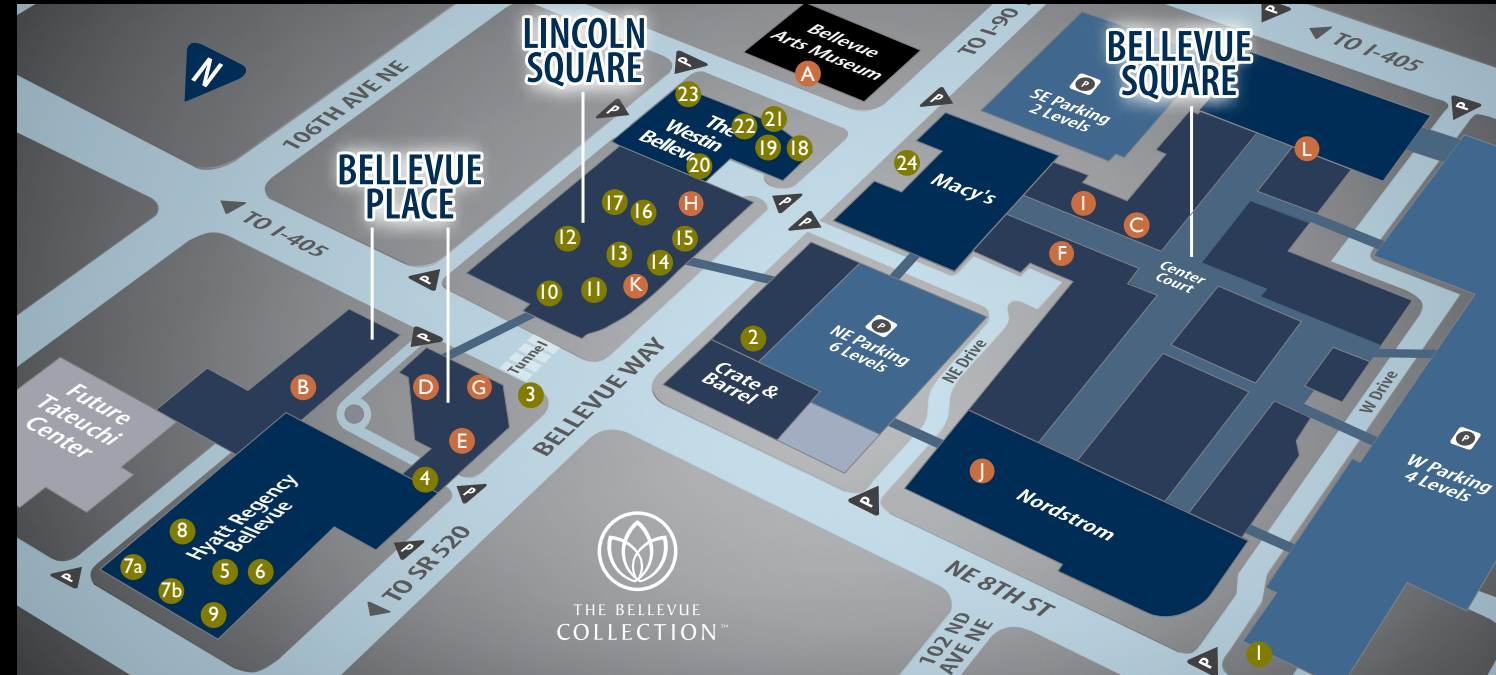
